

Installation Instructions

Rack-Mounting Kit for StoneGate Appliances

This kit adapts StoneGate 310 Series appliances for rack-mounting.

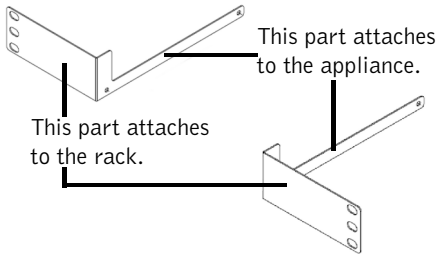
Parts Included

- 2 mounting brackets
- Screws for attaching the brackets to the appliance

Other Parts and Tools Required

- Phillips (cross-head) screwdriver
- Parts and tools required to attach the brackets to a rack

ILLUSTRATION 1 Bracket Parts

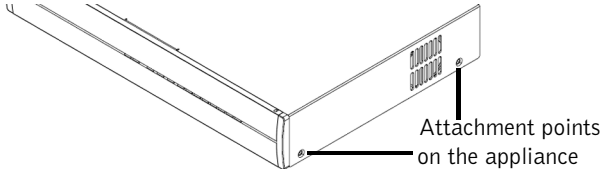


Attaching the Brackets

 **Warning** – Disconnect all cables from the appliance before you begin.

1. Unscrew the four screws on the side of the appliance. These screws are no longer needed.

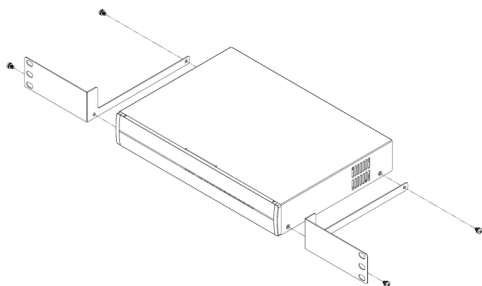
ILLUSTRATION 2 Location of the Screws



2. Line up the narrower part of the bracket with the screw holes on the side of the appliance and the wider part of the bracket with the front of the

appliance. Attach the bracket firmly using the screws provided in the rack-mounting kit. See [Illustration 3](#).

Warning – Do not attach the brackets to the appliance with the original screws that you removed from the appliance. The original screws are not long enough to attach the brackets properly.

3. Repeat for the other side. See [Rack-Mounting](#) below for the instructions for rack-mounting.

Rack-Mounting

Attach the appliance with the rack-mounting kit to a rack with suitable screws and cage nuts (not included in the delivery) through the holes on the wider part of the brackets.

You can rack-mount 310 Series appliances with this kit in slots that are on top of each other without leaving a space between the appliances. In that case, remove the rubber feet from the bottom of the appliance (for example, with a screwdriver) before attaching the rack-mounting kit to the rack.



Warning – If you mount other types of devices in the same rack, you may have to leave a 1U space empty for ventilation between the 310 Series appliance and the other devices. The devices may overheat and malfunction if they are placed directly on top or under a 310 Series appliance. Refer to the device-specific rack-mounting instructions for more information.
