

Installation Instructions

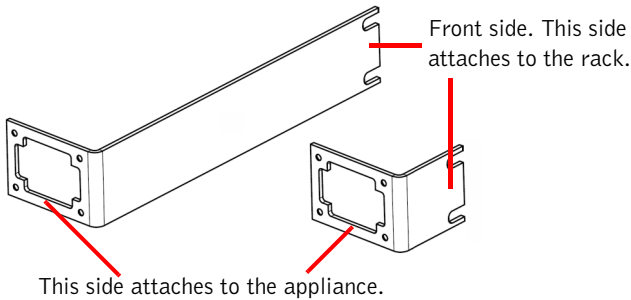
Rack-Mounting Kit for StoneGate Appliances

This kit adapts small StoneGate appliances for rack-mounting.

Parts Included

- 1 short mounting bracket
- 1 long mounting bracket

Other Parts and Tools Required

- Phillips (cross-head) screwdriver.
- Parts and tools required to attach the rack-mounting brackets to a rack.

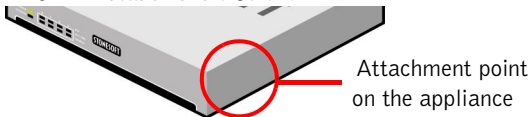
Attaching the Brackets



Warning – Disconnect all cables from the appliance before you begin.

1. Unscrew the four screws on the side of the appliance. Keep the screws.

2. Line up the bracket with the screw holes so that the front of the bracket is lined up with the front of the appliance and attach the bracket firmly using the original screws that you just screwed off.
3. Repeat for the other side. See the other page for the instructions for rack-mounting and the use of the short and long bracket.

Rack-Mounting

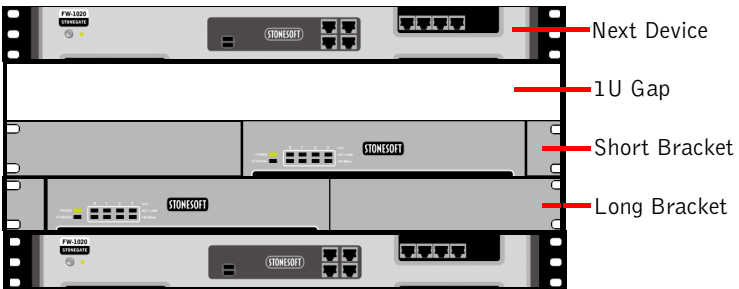
Attach the rack-mounting kit to a rack with suitable screws/bolts (not included) through the holes on the front of the brackets.



Warning – Leave a 1U space empty between the StoneGate appliance and any device on top of it in the rack. This space is needed for ventilation. If some other device is placed directly on top, the StoneGate appliance may overheat and malfunction.

StoneGate appliances mounted using this rack-mounting kit may be placed in slots that are on top of each other without leaving a space, but only if you alternate the sides where the shorter bracket is attached. This way, the actual appliances are not directly on top of each other and there is space for ventilation. See the illustration below for an example.
