

StoneGate Appliance Rack-Mounting Kit Installation

The rack-mounting kit adapts small StoneGate appliances for rack-mounting that are not directly rack-mountable.

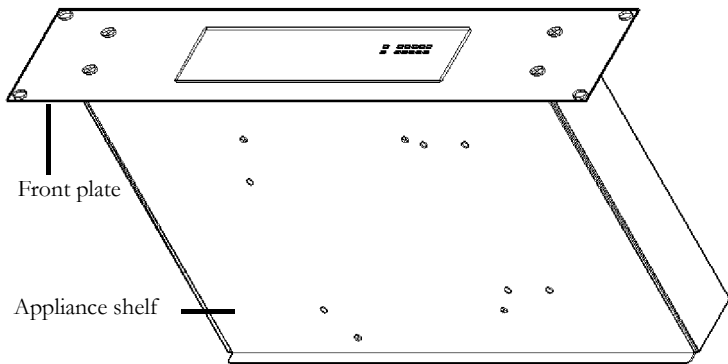
Parts Included

- 4 larger screws
- 10 smaller screws
- Front plate
- Appliance shelf (the main part)

Other Parts and Tools Required

- Phillips (cross-head) screwdriver
- Parts and tools required to attach the rack-mounting kit to a rack

Attaching the Appliance



Warning – Disconnect all cables from the appliance before you begin.

1. Place the appliance with its bottom up on a flat surface.
2. If the appliance has rubber studs glued to the bottom (for the appliance to stand on), remove the studs.
3. Place the appliance shelf on top of the appliance so that the four large screw holes are on the same side as the front of the appliance.
4. Line up the screw holes on the appliance shelf to the screw holes on the bottom of the appliance.
5. Screw in the ten smaller screws.
6. Press the appliance tightly against the appliance shelf and tighten the screws.

Attaching the Front Plate

1. Place the appliance shelf on a sturdy flat surface on its end so that the four large screw holes for the front plate are pointing directly upward. Be careful not to let the appliance shelf fall over.
2. Place the front plate on the appliance shelf so that the grooves for the screwheads are facing upward.
3. Line up the screw holes to those in the appliance shelf and fasten tightly with the larger screws.

Rack-Mounting

1. After attaching the front plate, turn over the rack-mounting kit so that the appliance is the right way up.
2. Attach the rack-mounting kit to a rack with suitable screws/bolts through the holes in the front plate.



Warning – Never install the appliance upside down in the rack (so that it hangs from the screws). The screws may not be able to support the appliance for a prolonged period of time.
